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## **Vaughan to Run for Local Hospital on Sunday May 29, 2011**

VAUGHAN, ON - For the 7<sup>th</sup> consecutive year, residents of city of Vaughan and York region will run, jog and walk in support Vaughan's first hospital. As a Community initiative, "Run for Vaughan" has donated \$300,000 to Vaughan Health Care Foundation and had over 1,100 participants in 2010.

The Run for Vaughan is a 10km and 3km run and 3km walk that takes place in Maple, Ontario. In addition to attracting many professional and amateur runners and walkers, the Run for Vaughan is a family event that attracts participants from across the region.

Everyone is welcome at Run for Vaughan; from children to seniors and mothers and fathers with baby strollers. There will be lots of fun, food, prizes and carnival. Many participants canvass the community for pledges and become eligible to win amazing prizes generously donated by the community.
